Experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms Fever or chills Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Fatigue Muscle or body aches Headache New loss of taste or smell Sore throat - Congestion or runny nose Nausea or vomiting Diarrhea	Get tested for COVID-19 when symptoms are consistent with COVID-19. If COVID-19 is ruled out, student may return for in-person instruction and all extracurricular activities when: • At least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; AND • Other symptoms are improving	<ul> <li>COVID-19 Positive</li> <li>Students need to stay home for at least five days after the start of symptoms (or after the date of first positive test if no symptoms). Test date or symptom onset date is day zero, whoever came first.</li> <li>Isolation can end after day 5 if symptoms are not present or are resolving and a test collected on day 5 or later tests negative. Antigen test recommended</li> <li>You do not need to provide proof of a negative test to your school site in order for your student to return.</li> <li>If fever is present, isolation should be continued until 24 hours after fever resolves.</li> <li>If symptoms, other than fever, are not resolving, continue to isolate</li> </ul>	
<b>Exposed to COVID-19</b> Not experiencing any symptoms	Students exposed to someone with COVID-19 do not need to quarantine unless they become symptomatic or test positive. Students may participate in all academic and extracurricular activities.	<ul> <li>In symptoms, other than revel, are not resolving, continue to isolate until symptoms are resolving or until after day 10.</li> <li>Per CDPH/CCHS masking guidance, infected persons should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days.</li> <li><u>CDPH Table 1:</u> Persons Who Should Isolate</li> <li>SRVUSD Education Center 699 Old Orchard Drive, Danville Monday - Friday; 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. <u>Appointment is required</u></li> </ul>
