<p>Experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms Fever or chills Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Fatigue Muscle or body aches Headache New loss of taste or smell Sore throat - Congestion or runny nose Nausea or vomiting Diarrhea</p>	<p>Get tested for COVID-19 when symptoms are consistent with COVID-19.</p> <p>If COVID-19 is ruled out, student may return for in-person instruction and all extracurricular activities when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; AND • Other symptoms are improving
<p>Exposed to COVID-19 Not experiencing any symptoms</p>	<p>Students exposed to someone with COVID-19 do not need to quarantine unless they become symptomatic or test positive.</p> <p>Students may participate in all academic and extracurricular activities.</p> <p>CDPH Table 2, Recommended Actions: Close Contacts - General Public (No Quarantine)</p>

<p>COVID-19 Positive</p>	
<p>Students need to stay home for at least five days after the start of symptoms (or after the date of first positive test if no symptoms). <i>Test date or symptom onset date is day zero, whoever came first.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Isolation can end after day 5 if symptoms are not present or are resolving and a test collected on day 5 or later tests negative. <i>Antigen test recommended.</i> • You do not need to provide proof of a negative test to your school site in order for your student to return. • If fever is present, isolation should be continued until 24 hours after fever resolves. • If symptoms, other than fever, are not resolving, continue to isolate until symptoms are resolving or until after day 10. • Per CDPH/CCHS masking guidance, infected persons should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days. <p>CDPH Table 1: Persons Who Should Isolate</p>
