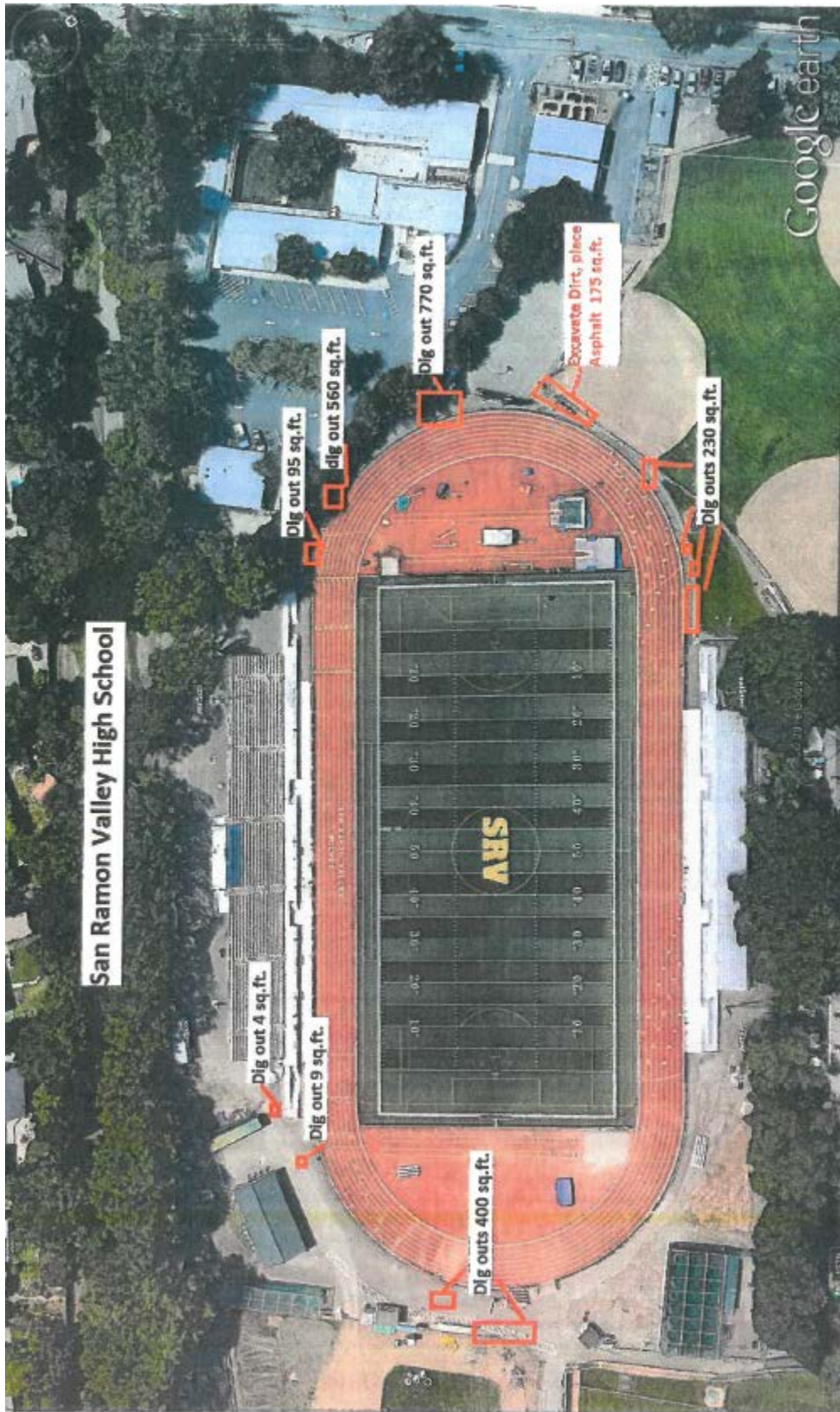

ITEM 4:

Question: Will there be an Engineer's Estimate for the bond?

Answer: **Stuart will provide \$650,000**

ITEM 5:

Question: Start date?

Answer: **June 4, 2018. Contractors will have remainder of June and all of July to complete work. All work must be completed prior to teacher's return on August 1, 2018**

ITEM 6:

Question: Square footage provided?

Answer: **All square footage provided in specs. and Addenda Blacktop to be 4" thick on playgrounds and walkways; 6" on roads and parking lots. Most of surface will be 4"**

ITEM 7:

Question: Schedule?

Answer: **Contractor will be held to District approved schedule provided by Contractor. Schedules will not be changed due to changed circumstances of contractor. Contractor to abide by schedule due to presence of children on premises.**

ITEM 8:

Question: Will SRVUSD provide an addendum to the scope of work for this project as we have in the past?

Answer: **No**

ITEM 9:

Question: Pruning of trees required?

Answer: **No**

ITEM 10:

Question: Headerboard?

Answer: **Some planter areas around Alamo School. Approximately 900 linear feet of headerboard required at area G (Alamo). Use pressure treated 2x4"**

ITEM 11:

Question: Skinpatch?

Answer: **No skinpatch in current scope. May be added as needed.**

ITEM 12:

Question: Tree roots?

Answer: **Nothing significant**

ITEM 13:

Question: Striping?

Answer: **All markings and striping to be re-done to match what was existing prior to work being done. Fire lines at Greenbrook, Parking stripes and crosshatching at Monte Vista**

ITEM 14:

Question: Schedule for Cal High changing due to pool use by City?

Answer: [Craig Cesco to have answer soon](#)

ITEM 15:

Question: Will fencing be removed and replaced by the district to provide access to various seal coat and asphalt replacement areas.

Answer: [Yes, District will remove horizontal rails and roll back fence fabric and reinstall after work is performed. Contractor will be responsible for temporarily securing affected areas of fence that are open and exposed when contractor is not present. \(roll back and wire fence fabric \)](#)

ITEM 16:

Question: The Individual Area School Report for California High Area F calls for recommended treatment of Remove & Replace Asphalt/ ADA Improvements. The Revised Bid Schedule does not address ADA Improvements. Are ADA Improvements going to be performed and if so what will the scope include.

Answer: [There are no ADA improvements intended for this area.](#)

ITEM 17:

Question: Will access routes that have to encroach on existing landscaping (lawn) be the responsibility of the contractor to replace back in kind.

Answer: [Yes, contractor is responsible for protecting adjacent areas and will be responsible for replacing back in kind for any damage to those areas.](#)

ITEM 18:

Question: [Alamo School – Area F1](#)

At the bidders conference we were told concrete tables would be moved away by the school district. There are 8 concrete tables, 8 metal tables and one concrete trash container. Will all of these items be moved by SRVUSD prior to paving?

Answer: [Yes](#)

ITEM 19:

Question: [Alamo School Area I](#)

Will the ramp leading to the YMCA portable need to be removed and replaced during paving operations. If so will SRVUSD do this work?

Answer: [It will not be removed](#)

ITEM 20:

Question: We were told when we visited the site that YMCA Camp will be held all summer at this location. The YMCA portable is in this location. Will we have 100% access with no camp activity in this area when this area will be paved?

Answer: [The intention is to work with Facilities Use to find a 2 day window to perform the work without the camp activity interfering.](#)

ITEM 21:

Question: [California High – Area F](#)

In the paving evaluation the recommended treatment states “Remove/Replace/ADA Improvements. There were no ADA improvements noted in the Scope of Work recap provided. Are there any specific ADA improvements that need to be completed?

Answer: [No ADA Improvements are part of this scope](#)

ITEM 22:

Question: Greenbrook Elementary Area C & Monte Vista Area F

At the bidders conference the only area that was discussed that needed header boards installed was the Alamo School baseball path. There are header boards in the existing pathways. Do we need to include installing header boards at these locations?

Answer: Yes

ITEM 23:

Question: Monte Vista – Area I

At the bidders conference we were advised that Asphalt depth should be 4” on playgrounds and walkways and 6” on roads and parking lots. The Scope of Work calls for removing and replacing the pathway **west of the stadium (assuming West of Commons)**. The asphalt evaluation describes the area as a road that exhibits moderate alligatoring. Should the asphalt be removed and replaced at 4” or 6” **“That is listed as a 1,010 sq.ft. road. Assume 6”.**

To ensure consistency and to avoid confusion it would be helpful if AC depth could be clarified for each location outline on the bid form.

Answer: See above in blue

ITEM 24:

Question: Painting curbs

Should painting curbs be included in the striping portion of the Scope of Work?

Answer: District will be responsible for painting curbs
