6.1a	<b>Project Updates</b>	Erin Hirst presented a PowerPoint presentation of current and completed projects.					
		Project update:  Twin Creeks Elementary School - Modernization  Plans were submitted to Division of State Architect (DSA) and the district has received comments back from DSA. The architect is working on those comments and will resubmit to DSA for final approval. The estimate came in alignment to the adjusted construction budget.					
6.1b	MPB Revision Updates and Recommendations	Danny Hillman clarified the percentage completed for Stone Valley Middle School noting that the financial completion is 77% and the building (construction) is					

approximately 95% complete.

Mr. Hillman explained the MPB budget revisions regarding California High School Science modernization project. This project has been closed out and the remaining

funds were moved to the Program Balance (Unassigned Budgets).

Danny Hillman reviewed the Explanation List for Project Expenses over \$100,000 – MPB 06-30-20 report and the Measure D Fund Balance Reconciliation Aide through 6-30-2020, noting that the reconciliation aide report ties to the annual Measure D Audit.

#### **6.2** Subcommittee Reports

#### 6.2a Finance

Jay Clark reported that on September 10, 2020 the Finance Subcommittee met and reviewed the Master Program Budget (MPB) which reflected updated expenditures through June 30, 2020. The Finance Subcommittee discussed and concurred with staff's proposed changes.

#### 6.2b Design

The Design Subcommittee toured Twin Creeks Elementary School on May 14, 2020. Chris King asked if the Design Subcommittees suggested modifications on the exterior window heights were considered before sending the project to DSA. This modification would raise the window heights so the wall can be utilized and make the classroom more functional.

Erin Hirst commented that the windows heights were adjusted before sending the plans to DSA.

#### Project left to design:

Alamo Elementary School – replacement of two existing Science and computer lab relocatables.

#### Allocation of remaining funds:

The Finance and Design Subcommittees discussed having a future joint meeting to discuss next steps regarding the unspent unallocated funds, how does it meet the original intent of the bond language. Staff will bring recommendations based on the bond criteria after Twin Creeks Elementary School and Charlotte Wood Middle School – Inc 2 go out to bid and the bids are solidified. Also begin the design for Alamo Elementary School and California High School kitchen renovation which was deferred while the California High School commons renovations were done.

#### 6.2c Communication

Scott Seidenverg noted that the Annual Measure D Facilities Oversight and Advisory Committee Report 2019 is due. The committee discussed ideas on how to create an annual report that represents the FOAC and the progress that has been made. Mr. Seidenverg asked for volunteers to assist in preparing the annual report. Jay Clark, Chris King, Rumi Varma, and Jerome Pandell volunteered.

#### Explanation List for Project Expenses over \$100,000 - MPB 10-09-20

San Ramon Valley High School: progress on SRV building, \$700k costs for 3 months. This includes \$158k construction costs and \$590k for the multi-use turf field improvements costs.

Stone Valley Middle School: progress on SV building and MPR, \$296k costs for 3 months. This includes \$126k for the new classroom quad landscaping, \$73k construction costs and \$97k for other professional services (architect, inspection, specialty consultant, and miscellaneous construction costs).

Vista Grande Elementary School Modernization, \$173k costs for 3 months. This includes renovation work to Admin. Building 400 and security fencing costs for 3 months.

Green Valley Elementary School Modernization, \$335k costs for 3 months. This is for the kindergarten play yard and courtyard improvements costs.

Sycamore Valley Elementary School Modernization, \$717k costs for 3 months. This includes \$591k for renovation/modernization costs and \$126k for other professional services (architect, and inspection).

CR and Infrastructure Technology, \$499k costs for 3 months. This includes the purchase of 400 laser projectors (\$456k) & network install costs at Monte Vista High School classroom (\$33k).

Energy Management Systems, \$178k costs for 3 months.

Measure D Program Expense: \$426k costs for 3 months. This includes employee salaries, consultants, and legal costs.
