

Welcome to the San Ramon Valley Unified School District Board of Education meeting. Your interest in our schools is greatly appreciated.

The SRVUSD Board of Education temporarily transitioned to holding their board meetings and accepting public comment virtually due to the physical distancing and social gathering limitations in effect during the COVID-19 pandemic. Beginning March 30, 2021, board meetings will be held at the San Ramon Valley High School Theater

Members of the public who wish to submit public comment at the SRVUSD Board Meetings, may do so in one of two ways.

- 1. Attend the meeting and complete a Public Comment Card. Give the card to Cindy Fischer and you will be called up to the podium to present your comments in person.
- 2. Email your comments to publiccomments@srvusd.net. Emails will be automatically forwarded to each board member and will be entered into the official minutes.
 - a. Public comments received from the time the agenda is posted through the end of the open session portion of the meeting, will be included in the minutes.
 - b. Public comments received 4 hours or less prior to the start of open session will be included in the minutes, but may not be read by all Board Members prior to the meeting.
 - c. No email attachments will be accepted with electronically submitted public comment.
 - d. Email addresses will not be included in the public record in order to protect the privacy of commenters.

By law, board members can only discuss items that appear on the agenda. For this reason, board members do not engage in dialogue with individuals speaking during the non-agenda public comment section of the meeting. For individuals who wish to speak with board members in depth about an issue, contacting board members on an individual basis is recommended, although individual board members have no legal authority to make decisions without consideration by the whole board.

All public comments during the meeting will be limited to three minutes.

Closed Session: Closed session meetings are not open to the public. By law, matters dealing with students and district employees are reserved for closed session to provide confidentiality. Other closed session topics can include litigation, property negotiations, and collective bargaining issues with employee associations. Members of the public are given the opportunity to speak regarding closed session items prior to the closed session.

Action items are considered and voted on individually by the board. Consent items are considered routine in nature and are approved by combining them into a single vote. A member of the Board of Education or a member of the public may request that a consent item be removed from the consent agenda and voted on separately.

Copies of board agenda backup and other informational materials provided to members of the Board of Education are available for review in the Office of the Superintendent beginning at 4:00 PM on the last working day of the week preceding each meeting of the Board of Education. For disability related modification or accommodation, please contact the Office of the Superintendent at 552-2933 during business hours.

Yes, I realize we are still in a pandemic BUT that the guidelines put out by the CDC have drastically changed over the past 8 days.

As has been the theme for the past 15 months.....Pivot

Well, John Malloy, John Campopiano, Dan Hillman, and elected Board Members, it is time to pivot and take the correct action by allowing San Ramon Valley High School Seniors to have ONE, outdoor, socially distant, mask graduation.

It is possible!

Have you thought of these options:

- 1. All student get 2 tickets = same number of people in attendance the day of the event
- 2. Take a poll and find out how many seniors will actually be attending graduation. Some may not attend for the same reasons they have not returned to campus. Maybe there isn't an issue.

RESOLUTION NO. 74/20-21 DESIGNATING MAY 1-31 AS MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS May 2021 has been designated National Mental Health Awareness month in the United States since 1949 by the Mental Health America organization;

WHEREAS, families have been deeply affected by the pandemic, and children are likely facing increased stress due to the changes, fear and uncertainty caused by illness, isolation, impending homelessness, and job and healthcare loss at rates never before seen; and

WHEREAS, children and families are dealing with the long overdue societal reckoning with police violence against African Americans, a spike in anti-Asian hate crimes and significantly higher-than-average death rates linked to COVID-19 among Latino communities; and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports that more than 20 percent of youth have a diagnosed mental health disorder in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the average age of early signs of mental illness is 14, when most students are entering high school; and

WHEREAS, an estimated 60 percent of students with emotional, behavioral and mental health disorders do not graduate from high school, according to the U.S. Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, the number of children ages 6-12 who visited children's hospitals for suicidal thoughts or self-harm has more than doubled since 2016, according to the Children's Hospital Association; and

WHEREAS, children, youth, and adults can recover from mental illness and lead full, productive lives at school and in the community;

WHEREAS, addressing the complex mental health needs of our children, youth and families places upon our community and school is a critical responsibility.

WHEREAS, schools that implement comprehensive mental health systems see improved academic performance, fewer special education placements, decreased disciplinary actions and higher graduation rates; and

WHEREAS, spreading awareness of the importance of mental health can help people realize the many ways in which mental illness impacts them and those around them, and can provide the opportunity to learn about available services.

WHEREAS, it is the desire and vision of the Board of Education to have students, employees and families of SRVUSD share a belief that an appropriate time should be set apart every day for the direction of our thoughts specifically toward our children's mental health and wellbeing.

DISCUSSION: Assembly Bill (AB) 1200 and AB 2756 require local educational agencies to publically disclose the major provisions of all collective bargaining agreements before entering into a written agreement. Government Code, section 3547.5 states:

"Before a public school employer enters into a written agreement with an exclusive representative covering matters within the scope of representation, the major provisions of the agreement, including, but not limited to, the costs that would be incurred by the public school employer under the agreement for the current and subsequent fiscal years, shall be disclosed at a public meeting of the public school employer in a format established for this purpose by the Superintendent of Public Instruction."

This provision is intended to ensure that the public is aware of the known costs associated with a proposed collective bargaining agreement before it becomes binding upon the district.

In addition, the law requires that a district's Superintendent and Chief Business Officer (CBO) certify in writing that the costs incurred under a collective bargaining agreement can be met by the district during the term of the agreement. The Public Disclosure Form, along with a copy of the proposed bargaining agreement, must be submitted to the County Office of Education for review at least (10) workdays prior to the date on which the Governing Board will take action on the proposed collective bargaining agreement.

The district has signed Memoranda of Understanding with SRVEA, CSEA Units II and III, and SEIU to provide a one-time payment of \$2,500 to each employee in paid status in 2020-21, prorated to her/his position FTE, and will provide the same one-time payment under the same terms to all Management and Confidential employees, this school year. In accordance with requirements of the AB 1200, staff has prepared the AB 1200 Public Disclosure documents along with Certification that the district can meet the costs incurred under the agreement over its term.

The Contra Costa County Office of Education has reviewed your District's Negotiated Salary Settlement Disclosure documents that provide the details for the one-time tentative agreement with all District bargaining units and management for fiscal year 2020-21.

The AB 1200 disclosure documents based on the adopted state budget indicate that the District will be able to provide the funding necessary for the one-time off schedule payment of \$2,500 (plus statutory benefits). Based on our analysis of the disclosure documents, it appears this settlement agreement will result in an increase of \$7,198,829 to the District. We cautiously agree that the District can afford this salary settlement.

The historical volatility of state revenues, the one-time nature of federal stimulus, and the known cost pressures of school operations due to COVID-19 requirements require careful planning when developing the district's multi-year budget projection. If the District's projected ADA and Revenue Assumptions come in lower than expected or Federal Stimulus dollars do not materialize, then the district may need to look at reductions and/or increased attention to cash flow management.

CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION 73/20-21, AUTHORIZATION TO SIGN WE CAN WORK CONTRACT

DISCUSSION: The San Ramon Valley Unified School District and the Department of Rehabilitation (DOR) Greater East Bay District are entering into another agreement to work collaboratively with the district's high school students aged 16-21 with disabilities who can benefit from "We Can Work" (WCW) services. The district has participated in this program for the last several years and it is huge success for our students.

The Federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunities Act (WIOA) require that the Department of Rehabilitation provide "DOR Student Services" to high school students ages 16-21 with all types of disabilities. DOR Student Services are an outcome oriented and coordinated set of activities that promotes movement from school to post school activities.

The services provided to our students include core services such as, job exploration counseling, work based learning experiences, counseling on post-secondary opportunities, workplace readiness training, and instruction in self-advocacy. Students with all types of disabilities from California, Del Amigo, Dougherty Valley, Monte Vista, San Ramon Valley and Venture High Schools will be referred to DOR for WCW services. Work experiences are intended to be temporary placements to help the student gain experience in the workplace and they may also result in the development of vocational direction, appropriate work attitudes, ethics, interpersonal skills, speed, and accuracy as well as some limited occupational skills.

This two year contract will focus specifically on the provisions of "work based learning experiences" and will serve at a minimum of 26 unduplicated DOR participants for fiscal year 2021-22, and a minimum of 25 unduplicated DOR participants for fiscal year 2022-2023. The DOR will reimburse the school district for actual expenses incurred for this program up to \$144,000 through June 30, 2023.

RECOMMENDATION: The Administration requests adoption of resolution 73/20-21, authorizing Chief Business Officer, Greg Medici to sign and execute any and all documents required by DOR to effectuate the execution of contracts and or amendments.

CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF REVISION TO ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION 6158, INDEPENDENT STUDY

DISCUSSION: Periodically Administration reviews Board Policies to assure they are current and in compliance with the California Education Code.

This year we have made changes to the way we process short term Independent Study contracts at all sites. These contracts and related forms are now processed completely electronically. This is more efficient and will result in fewer lost documents and reduced in-person and email contacts. In order to be consistant with district practice and Education Code, the following changes have been made.

- Current Education code 51747.5 no longer requires the signature or initials on student work products by the supervising teacher.
- To allot teachers enough time to gather assignments and post to the contract, students shall give minimum 5 school days notice when requesting 5 to 10 days of planned absence and minimum of 10 school days notice when requesting abenses of more than 10 days.

RECOMMENDATION: Administration recommends that the Board adopt the revised Administrative Regulation 6158, Independent Study.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: There are no budget implications anticipated due to these revisions.

Independent Study

No student shall be required to participate in independent study. (Education Code 51747)

No course required for high school graduation shall be offered exclusively through independent study. (Education Code 51745)

No individual with exceptional needs, as defined in Education Code <u>56026</u>, may participate in independent study unless his or her individualized education program specifically provides for such participation. (Education Code <u>51745</u>)

Students enrolling in independent study must be residents of the county or an adjacent county. (Education Code 51747.3)

No more than 10 percent of the students enrolled in Continuation or Opportunity Education may be on independent study at any given time. (Education Code 51745)

A temporarily disabled student may not receive individual instruction through independent study; instead they may receive Home & Hospital instruction pursuant to Education Code <u>48206.3</u>. (Education Code <u>51745</u>)

The district shall not provide independent study students and parents/guardians with funds or items of value that are not provided for other students and parents/guardians. (Education Code 46300.6, 51747.3)

Students age 21 or older, and students age 19 or older who have not been continuously enrolled in school since their 18" birthday, may participate in independent study through the adult education program. (Education Code 46300.1)

Full-time independent study shall not be available to students whose district residency status is based on their parent/guardian's employment within district boundaries. (Education Code 51747.3)

Each student's independent study shall be coordinated, evaluated and carried out under the general supervision of a supervising teacher. (Education Code <u>51747.5</u>)

Criteria for Participation

Students who are interested in independent study should contact their school principal. Approval for participation shall be based on the following criteria:

- 1. An acceptable reason for requesting independent study.
- 2. Evidence that the student will work independently to complete the program.
- 3. Availability of experienced certificated staff with adequate time to supervise the student effectively.
- 4. A written statement indicating educational objectives, how the objectives will be accomplished, and how progress toward the objectives will be measured.

Written Agreements and Assignments

- 1. The manner, frequency, time and place for submitting the student's assignments and for reporting his or her progress.
- 2. The objectives and methods of study for the student's work, and the methods used to evaluate that work.
- 3. The specific resources, including materials and staff, which will be made available to the student.
- 4. A copy of the district's independent study policy, describing the maximum length of time allowed between an assignment and its completion and the number of missed assignments which will trigger an evaluation of whether the student should be allowed to continue in independent study.
- 5. The duration of the independent study agreement, including the beginning and ending dates for the student's participation in independent study under the agreement. No independent study agreement shall be valid for any period longer than one school year.
- 6. A statement of the number of course credits or, for the elementary grades, other measures of academic accomplishment appropriate to the agreement, to be earned by the student upon completion.
- 7. A statement that independent study is an optional educational alternative in which no student may be required to participate.
- 8. In the case of a student who is referred or assigned to any school, class or program pursuant to Education Code 48915 or 48917, the agreement also shall include the statement that instruction may be provided through independent study only if the student is offered the alternative of classroom instruction.

Before beginning the independent study, each written agreement shall be signed and dated by the student, the parent/guardian of the student less than 18 years of age, the supervising teacher designated as responsible for the general supervision of independent study, and all persons who have direct responsibility for providing assistance to the student. (Education Code 51747)

The agreement shall state that the parent/guardian's signature confers his or her permission for the student's independent study as specified in the agreement.

Students Rights and Responsibilities

Students participating in independent study shall have the right, continuously, to enter or return to the regular classroom mode of instruction.

Independent study students who are late, miss scheduled conferences or do not submit assigned work on time shall not be reported as tardy or truant. However, the independent study administrator shall promptly and directly address any failure by the student to meet the terms of his or her written agreement.

Records

District records shall identify all students participating in independent study and shall specify the grade level, program placement, and school in which each of these students is enrolled. (Education Code 51748)

Each school shall maintain records for the students at that school.

- 1. A copy of the district policy, administrative regulation, and procedures related to independent study.
- 2. A file of all agreements, with representative samples of each student's work products reviewed bearing signed or initialed and dated notations by the supervising teacher indicating that he/she has personally evaluated the work or that he/she has personally reviewed the evaluations made by another certificated teacher.
- 3. A list of participating students, by grade level, program and school, who have participated in independent study, identifying units of the curriculum attempted and units of the curriculum completed by students in grades K-8 and identifying course/credits attempted by and awarded to students in grades 9-12, continuation and in adult education, as specified their written agreements.
- 4. An attendance register separate from other attendance records.
- 5. A record of grades and other evaluations issued to each student for independent study assignments.

Supportive Strategies

- 1. The administrator shall incorporate in program procedures the appropriate use of the following strategies to deal with missed appointments or late assignments:
- 2. A letter to the student and/or parent/guardian, as appropriate.
- 3. A special meeting between the student and the teacher and/or counselor
- 4. A meeting between the student and the administrator, including the parent/guardian if appropriate
- 5. An increase in the amount of time the student works under direct supervision.

When the student has missed the number of assignments specified in Board policy as precipitating an evaluation, the Superintendent or designee shall conduct an evaluation which may result in termination of the independent study agreement, with the student's return to a regular classroom or alternative instructional program.

Independent Study for Pre-Determined Absences

Students may be given the opportunity to complete a written independent study contract during a planned absence from regular classes for a period of five (5) or more consecutive instructional days. The following guidelines shall apply:

- 1. The parent and student shall be responsible for initiating the request for an independent study contract.
- 2. No student is entitled to a short-term independent study agreement in excess of ten (10) but not to exceed twenty (20) consecutive instructional school days without approval by the principal. Venture's semester approval takes place through the enrollment process at that school site.
- 3. Requests for independent study contracts must be given to the teacher within the following limitations, except where an emergency exists and an exception is made by the principal:

Days of Consecutive Planned Absences No. of Days/Notice Prior to Absence

Students requesting 5 to 10 days of planned absence shall give 3 to minimum 5 school days notice prior to absence.

Students requesting more than 10 days of planned absence shall contact principal 5-to minimum 10 school days before leave request initiates.

Independent Study Supervising Teachers

The following regulations shall apply to the selection and duties of supervising teachers:

- 1. Teachers who directly supervise the independent study on a regular basis will be approved, prior to assignment, by the independent study administrator.
- 2. The principal of any school may recommend teachers and students for independent study. At the elementary level, the supervising teacher may be the classroom teacher. At the secondary level, one of the six teachers (or another teacher) must be assigned as the supervising teacher.
- 3. Independent study supervising teachers shall:
- a. Complete designated portions of the written agreement.
- b. Add additional information when appropriate.
- c. Supervise and approve coursework.
- d. Design all lesson plans.
- e. Write the assignments for students.
- f. Assess all student work.
- g. Personally review and evaluate the time value of work products completed, and submitted by the student or other teachers.
- h. Select and save with each agreement representative samples of the student's completed and evaluated assignments on not less than a monthly basis.
- i. Sign and complete the agreement when the student has reached his or her objectives or the agreement is terminated.
- j. Maintain any required records and files on a current basis.
- 4. Independent study teacher shall determine and assign grades or other approved measures of the student's achievement when appropriate.

Administration of Independent Study

The use of independent study shall be administered by the supervising teacher. His or her responsibility shall include:

1. Ensuring that independent study occurs in accordance with state law and district policy and regulations

- 2. Approving the participation of students requesting independent study for a period of five (5) or more 5/18/21 consecutive instructional days

- 3. Facilitating the completion of independent study written agreements
- 4. Approving all credits earned through independent study supervised at a location apart from the student's regular school and forwarding the information to the appropriate school staff so that it becomes part of the student's permanent record
- 5. Completing or coordinating the preparation of all necessary records and reports
- 6. Establishing and maintaining in a systematic manner all records required by state regulations for an audit trail of average daily attendance attributed to independent study
- 7. Personally review and evaluate each student's work products or review the evaluations made by another certificated teacher. The work products must be signed/initialed and dated by supervising teacher.

WHEREAS, with the use of Local Building Funds the San Ramon Valley School District has determined that four additional relocatables are needed for growth at California High School for the 2021/2022 school year; and

WHEREAS, in working with the district architect, tBP Architects, and the school advisory committee, designs have been established for the additional relocatable classrooms to be located on the basketball blacktop area north of the 3-story classroom building and connected to the campus electrical, telecom and fire alarm systems; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work also includes an accessible path of travel to the campus, its facilities, and the entrance; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the above mentioned plans would make the most efficient use of the existing facilities; and

WHEREAS, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15303, specifically exempts from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Pub. Resources Code, §§ 21000, et seq., "CEQA") construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure; and

WHEREAS, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15314, specifically exempts from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Pub. Resources Code, §§ 21000, et seq., "CEQA") consistent with CEQA (Section 15314) guidelines with respect to minor additions to existing schools within existing school grounds where the addition does not increase original student capacity by more than 25% or ten classrooms, whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, the Project does not involve any of the following and so is eligible for the categorical exemptions as described above under California Code of Regulations, Title 14, and section 15300.2:

- (a) The cumulative impact of successive projects of the same type in the same place, which over time is significant;
- (b) An activity where there is a reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances;

- (c) A project which may result in damage to scenic resources, including but not limited to, trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings, or similar resources, within a highway officially designated as a state scenic highway;
- (d) A project located on a site which is included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code; or
- (e) A project that may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource.

WHEREAS, upon a determination that the Project is exempt from CEQA, the District is entitled to file a Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15062.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board adopts the foregoing recitals as true and correct.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board finds that the Project is in the best interests of the District, and will increase safety and benefit students, staff, parents, visitors, and the community at large, and on that basis, the Board approves the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby finds that the Project is categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to Sections 15303 and 15314 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, that none of the exceptions set forth in California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15300.2 apply to the Project, and that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment; and
