Stone Valley Middle School – Modernization

 Erin Hirst read a narrative regarding a financial update, which lead to the final decision between the District and Liberty Mutual Insurance, the general contractor's bonding company that resulted in the release of the final funds for work performed.

At the time legal action was entered into, the contractor claimed that they were owed a little over \$7.4 M. The District came to an agreement with the contractors bonding company, Liberty Mutual Insurance, for \$2M. This enabled the District to finish the project fairly close to the original budget.

Twin Creeks Elementary School - Modernization

• Has been completed.

Twin Creeks Elementary School – K-Yard

• Out to bid.

Charlotte Wood Middle School – Modernization

• Has been completed.

Vista Grande Elementary School

• The covered walkways will be replaced over the summer. The District is in contract to shore up the existing conduits while the new covered walkways are being constructed.

Security Camera Installation - Districtwide

• The Security Camera Installation at Various Sites – Phase 3 went to bid on March 30, 2023. The contract will go to the Board on April 25, 2023 and anticipated to be completed over the summer.

Neil Armstrong Elementary School - Fencing

• The Neil Armstrong Elementary School Security Fencing & Gating went to bid on April 11, 2023. The contract will go to the Board on April 25, 2023.

Play Structures – Various Sites

- The district is in the process of updating four elementary school play structures making the structures age appropriate.
- 5.2b Long Range Facilities Plan
- The Long Range Facilities Committee has met with teachers and educators to talk about the future of the district and educational program opportunities. The consult, LPA Design Studios, has met with principals, educators, staff and students at each school site and compiled a Campus Visioning Report and a comprehensive Facilities Assessment Report for each site. The Campus Visioning Reports consist of the overall impression of the campus, traffic patterns, safety and security, outdoor areas, adequate play areas, areas for the school to assemble for school-wide functions, current learning spaces, Pre-K and TK classrooms and the immediate concerns of the current facilities. The Facilities Assessment Reports consist of an in depth report of the deficiencies and lifecycle needs identified in the assessments to provide the basis for a portfolio-wide capital improvement funding strategy. Facilities staff will meet with each principal to review each reports. The Long Range Facilities Development Plan committee, which have stakeholders throughout the District, have met twice with three meetings remaining. The third meeting will focus on the Educational Specifications that derived from a subcommittee focusing on topics that related to the educational programming and give input to finalize the specifications. These reports will be shared at the upcoming Town Hall meetings. The District is anticipating to take the draft report to the Board late fall or early winter 2023 with project prioritization.

Increase budget to cover old Feb 2021 Board approved contractor change order for which the project budget had not been previously revised.

Project ID #0516: Charlotte Wood Middle School Modernization - \$364,727

Includes general contractor construction services.

Project ID #0541: Twin Creeks Classroom Modernization - \$716,461

Includes general contractor construction services and exterior speaker installation.

Project ID #0527: Security Cameras - \$110,434

Includes security camera installation at various elementary school sites, parts and cables.

Project ID #0542: Gating and Fencing - \$113,468

Includes fencing work at Charlotte Wood MS and conceptual design services associated with campus fencing for Monte Vista HS
