6.2b Long Range Facilities Master Plan Update

Stella Kemp updated the committee on the Long Range Facilities Master Plan. In Spring 2022, the District formed a committee consisting of community members, students, staff, board members, administrators, representatives from the City of San Ramon and the Town of Danville to discuss what will be the vision for teaching and learning in the 21st century. The purpose of the plan is to do a thorough assessment of all school facilities in the district; 1) to determine the districts long term facility needs and determine what the long term repair will be such as HVAC replacements; 2) to make sure the facilities need are related to the enrollment and the TK-K program 3) ensure that the schools are designed to the District's Strategic Direction. Staff is planning to take The Long Range Facilities Master Plan to the Board for approval in spring / summer 2024.
